

Target Board—Question Examples:

Closed Questions:

- *What is $6 + 4 + 5$?
- *What is the total of 15cm and 0.64cm?

Open Questions:

- *Find two numbers that have a difference of six
- *Find three numbers with a total of 45%
- *Find two numbers with the sum of 100

Other Target Board Ideas:

1. Identify a number

- *Ask children how they could get to that answer using other numbers on the board

2. Using a Mystery Number

- *Give children hints about this number (e.g. is a multiple of 3 or is two more than a square number)

Using Numeracy Vocabulary:

- *Tell me an odd number
- *Which number is a factor of 6?
- *Which number is a multiple of 4?
- *How many prime numbers can you find
- *Sequence the numbers in the second row
- *Add the first number in the first column, and the last number in the last column
- *Take away the smallest number in the second row, from the largest number in the second row
- *Find two numbers with the sum of 100

- *Divide each number by three and total up the remainders
- *Round the numbers in the last row to the nearest ten and add them together
- *Find two numbers where one is half the other
